His birth according to the flesh was the revelation of the Godman, while the Theophany (or Epiphany) is the revelation of His divinity and the manifestation of the Most Holy Trinity.

This is a day of precept (holyday of obligation) for all Byzantine

Catholics. The Divine Liturgy and the Great Blessing of Water will be
celebrated at 10:00 AM. After Liturgy, we will also celebrate our patronal feast day with a catered
parish brunch in the narthex. Be sure to sign up next week so we can order food accordingly.
